Qualifications:

Must possess and retain a current license or registration in the State of Michigan in psychology, social work, counseling or nursing. The SA therapist will meet the criteria for Qualified Mental Health Professional including a Master's degree in Social Work, Counseling or Psychology with a LMSW, RN, LLP, or LPC, and two years post-master's experience in clinical services for adults. Also will possess CAAC credential. Must meet the requirements for either Qualified Mental Health Professional and is trained and experienced in the area of mental illness or substance abuse. Additional requirements include: cultural competency, ability to work effectively with a diverse population, the ability to engage and maintain therapeutic relationships with adolescent, adults and families in a variety of modes of treatment, the ability to develop collaborative relationships with other unit staff and providers, effective communication skills, and a willingness to be flexible.

The SA Therapist is responsible to provide clinical services to all adults meeting eligibility criteria for SA services. Services are delivered mainly in the office setting and include intakes, person centered treatment planning, provision of individual, family and/or group treatment based on client need and preference as well all documentation required. The SA Therapist is responsible for collaborating with professional team members to integrate service delivery. Working hours are typically Monday through Thursday 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m and 8:00 am to 4:30pm on Fridays. however, due to program and consumer needs, evening and weekend hours may also be required.
